ROADSIDE SPRAYING PROGRAM 2019

The Agricultural Service Board of the Municipal District of Bonnyville No. 87 and/or Contractors will commence spraying roadside ditches along provincial highways and other municipal roads, as required to control the spread of weeds and brush growth on or about June 1 and through the summer until the end of September.

Those landowners living along a Primary or Secondary Highway who are prepared to control the weeds along their property should contact Alberta Transportation, the maintenance contractor that looks after these highways. You will be asked to sign a Weed Control Agreement stating that you accept responsibility for the control of weeds in the ditch along your property. If you fail to control these by mowing or spraying, the M.D. or Alberta Transportation may control them by whatever means it considers appropriate.

Landowners are reminded that the road allowances are owned by the M.D. or by the Province in the case of provincial highways and any activity carried out within the road allowances are done at each persons own risk.
