MUNICIPAL ELECTION SPECIAL BALLOTS

The Municipal Election for the Council of the Municipal District of Bonnyville is on Monday, October 16, 2017.

This year, for the first time, the M.D. is providing residents with the opportunity to vote by Special Ballot.

Eligible voters can choose to vote by Special Ballot if:

- they are physically incapacitated or
- they are absent from the area on Advance Vote Day (Thursday, October 5) or Election Day

Voters can request a special ballot from the Returning Officer in writing, in person or by fax.

All Special Ballots must be completed and returned to the M.D. Main Administration office (4905-50 Ave. Bonnyville) by 4 p.m. on Election Day, October 16, 2017.
