PUBLIC NOTICE CLOSURE OF PUBLIC HIGHWAY

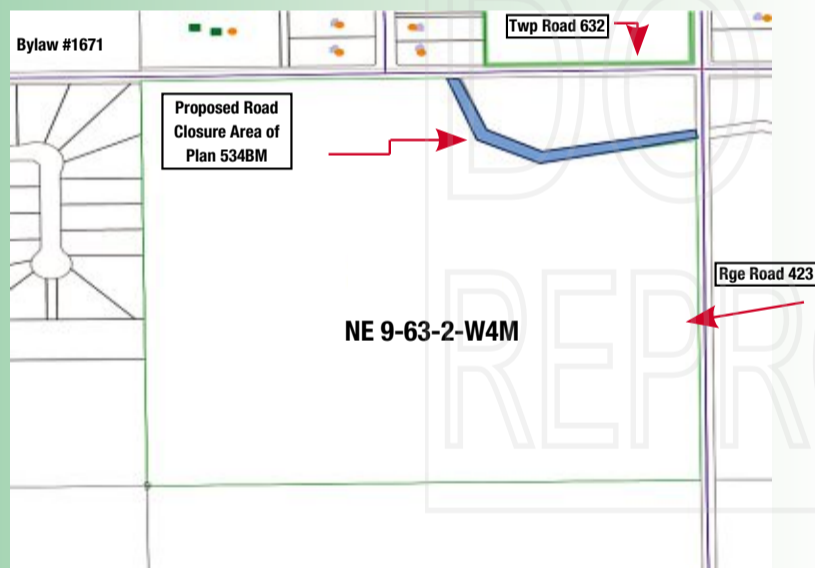
