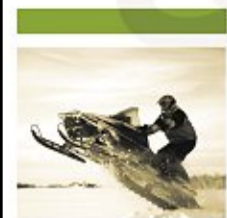

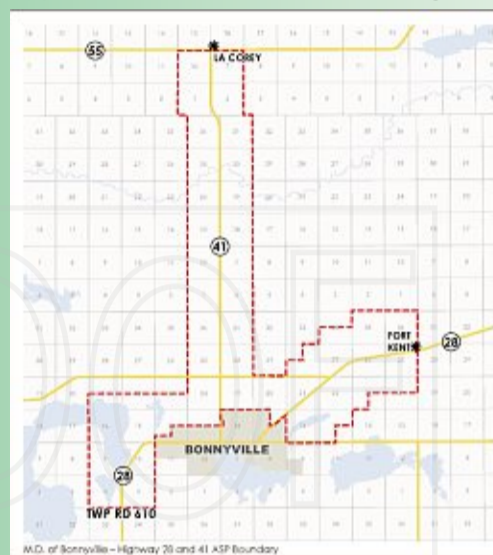

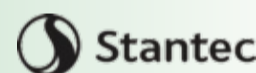
**Tell us your thoughts.**

## THE GOODRIDGE SOCIAL AND AGRICULTURAL SOCIETY BIDS FOR THE 2018 GRASS CUTTING SEASON

The contract begins May 15, 2018 and ends September 15, 2018, and includes the areas:

- Goodridge Hall/Fire Hall grounds
- Goodridge Hall playground
- Goodridge 4-H grounds

**The requirements of the contract are:**

- Grass cutting of grounds, line trimming around obstacles and perimeters.
- Removal of excess grass clippings, playground sand must be rotor tilled to keep sand free of compaction and weeds/grass. Rotor tilling should be done at least twice in the term of the contract.
- Grass cutting at the 4-H grounds would require line trimming around fence and building and grass cutting in the ditch.
- Grass cutting of the ball diamonds (located east of hall). Required to do a complete cutting of the area only once per month.

The successful bidder can expect four pay periods over the course of the contract with payments on the 20th of June through to September with submitted invoices. The successful bidder can expect to receive instructions from the Directors of the Society regarding the frequency of grass cutting.
