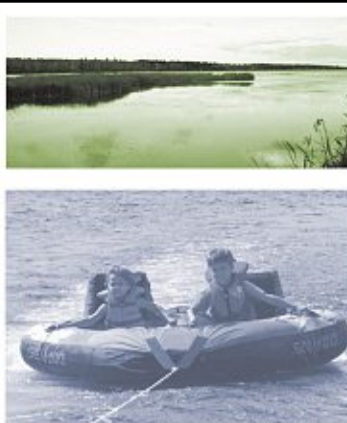

PROPERTY ASSESSORS MAKING THE ROUNDS

Please note, Municipal District of Bonnyville assessors are currently performing onsite property inspections for property assessment. These inspections are as per Municipal Government Act requirements.

Assessor vehicles will have an M.D. logo, and will be marked "Property Assessor".

When possible, assessors will leave a notification, with contact information, for property owners that they have visited the property.

WATERFOWL CROP DAMAGE PREVENTION PROGRAM

The M.D. of Bonnyville assists area farmers in the prevention of damage to crops done by waterfowl such as geese and ducks by providing scare cannons to deter waterfowl from feeding on seed crops. Scare cannons make a noise louder than a shotgun blast, one scare cannon per 40 acres provides optimum protection, especially when used with flags or scarecrows. Scare cannons detonate every 10 to 20 minutes using propane. The M.D. has six available for farmer use. The scare cannons are rented free-of-charge with a damage deposit.
