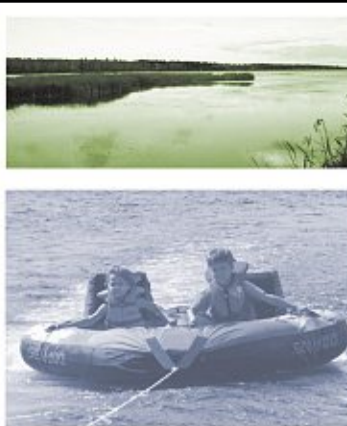

### LAND USE BYLAW NO. 570

Bylaw No. 1667, being the Municipal District of Bonnyville No. 87 Land Use Bylaw, be amended as follows:

#### Part 6 – General Regulations –

**Section 53 – Medical Marijuana and / or Cannabis Production Facilities** be amended

**Section 68 Land Use Regulations Chart** be amended

**Section 69.2, Discretionary Uses in the Agriculture District –A** be amended

**Section 76.2, Discretionary Uses in the Hamlet General District – HG** be amended

**Section 82.2, Discretionary Uses in the Rural Commercial District – RC** be amended

**Section 83.2, Discretionary Uses in the Rural Industrial District – RI** be amended

**Addition to Part 8 – Definitions** be amended to include:

Cannabis

Cannabis Production Facility

Cannabis Retail Establishment

**Amendment to Part 8 – Definitions** be amended regarding the following definitions:

Extensive Agriculture

General Commercial

Green-House / Plant Nursery

Intensive Agriculture

Retail Store building but does not include a cannabis retail establishment.

### LICENCE FOR TEMPORARY OCCUPATION AND LEASE OF GOVERNMENT ROAD ALLOWANCE

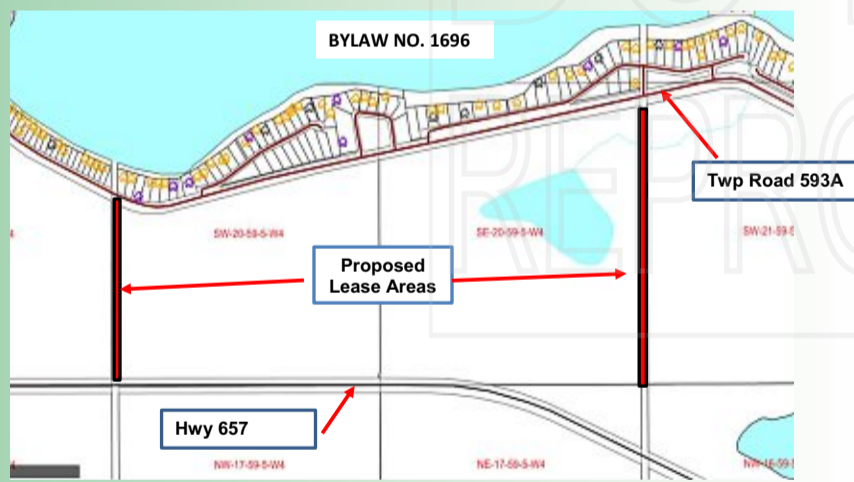

All that portion of the government road allowance West of the South West Quarter of Section 20, Township 59, Range 5, W4M (W / SW 20-59-5-W4M) and East of the South East Quarter of Section 20, Township 59, Range 5, West 4M (E / SE 20-59-5-W4M).
