M.D.'S ONLINE SHELTERBELT TREE PROGRAM GOES LIVE MARCH 9

Every year, the M.D. offers residents a chance to buy a variety of shelterbelt trees at a discount. This program has many benefits, including decreasing soil erosion, reducing wind damage to crops, increasing pollinator and wildlife habitats, improving safety in winter travel due to reduced snow drifting and much more.

The shelterbelt website is now live, so you can see what will be available. However, online orders will not open until March 9 at 8:30 a.m.

Please note – you will be required to input your legal land description on the order form to complete your purchase. This information can be found on your Tax and Assessment Notice.

Trees will be available on a first come, first served basis. The program will close April 15, 2020 or when trees are sold out.

Seasonal – Pest Control Assistant – This position has responsibilities which include assisting the Pest Control Officer with beaver control, farm inspections, clearing culverts and other duties as required. This opportunity will close March 9, 2020.

SMALL BUSINESS SUB-CLASS DEADLINE APPROACHING

This tax rate gives business owners paying a non-residential property tax levy the opportunity to qualify for a reduced property tax rate.
