## Roadside Spraying Program 2021

The Agricultural Service Board of the M.D. of Bonnyville No. 87 and/or contractors will commence spraying roadside ditches along provincial highways and other municipal roads, as required to control the spread of weeds and brush growth on or about June 1, and through the summer until the end of September.

Those landowners living along a Primary or Secondary Highway, who are prepared to control the weeds along their property, should contact Emcon, the maintenance contractor that looks after these highways. You will be asked to sign a Weed Control Agreement stating that you accept responsibility for the control of weeds in the ditch along your property. If you fail to control these by mowing or spraying, the M.D. or Alberta Transportation may control them by whatever means it considers appropriate.

If you live on a M.D. road, please contact our Ag Department at 780-826-3171 or go online at [www.md.bonnyville.ab.ca](http://www.md.bonnyville.ab.ca) to fill out the Weed Control Agreement.

Landowners are reminded that the road allowances are owned by the M.D. or by the Province (in the case of provincial highways), and any activity carried out within the road allowances are done at their own risk.

## Complete the 2021 Canada Census

The 2021 Canadian Census has started.

Every five years, Canadians are asked to complete the census. This helps governments make informed decisions about needed infrastructure in communities across Canada, including the M.D. of Bonnyville.

When it comes to federal grants for projects such as road rebuilding, recreation expansions (think the Aerial Adventure Park coming to Kinosoo Ridge), the Canadian government uses census data to help make its decisions.

It also helps record a snapshot of Canada for history and helps us understand more about the people who live in our community.

Farmers are also encouraged to complete the Census of Agriculture, which helps paint a picture of agriculture in Canada. From land use and crops to livestock and land management practices, the Ag Census can help farmers plan for the future.
