The M.D.'s 2021 Municipal Election will be held on Monday, October 18. If you are unable to make it to your voting station on Election Day, here are two other options to cast your ballot:

Special (Mail-In/Drop-Off) Ballots

Voters who are physically unable to vote in person, will be absent from the M.D., or are Election Officials who will not be able to vote on the day of the election due to their responsibilities, can vote via a Special Ballot.

All special ballots must be completed and physically received by the Returning Officer at the M.D. Administration Office at 4905-50 Ave. Bonnyville before 4 p.m. on Election Day, Monday, October 18, 2021.
