

RULES & REGULATIONS

- No person shall interfere with the rights of others to the quiet and peaceful enjoyment of the park.
- If generators are needed, please refrain from running your generators continuously throughout the day.
- **There will be zero tolerance for excessive noise from 11 p.m. to 7 a.m.**
- Park guests are expected to maintain clean sites. Please use garbage bins for waste - not fire pits. Campsites left in an unacceptable condition may result in a fine of \$200 - \$400.
- Alcohol is not allowed off of your assigned campsite at any time.
- Cannabis can only be used inside of your RV/tent.
- All dogs must be leashed AT ALL TIMES. Dogs are not allowed on the beach AT ANY TIME. Cleaning up after your pets is mandatory.
- The swimming and playground areas are NOT supervised. Use at own risk.
- Fireworks are prohibited in all M.D. Parks.
- OHVs are prohibited inside of the park.

RESERVATIONS

Reservations are recommended at Minnie Lake M.D. Parks. The part office begins taking reservations April 1. Weather permitting, the park is open from May 14 to September 12, 2021. Bookings will be accepted via telephone and online at www.campreservations.ca/welcome.

Camping During COVID-19

COVID-19 continues to be a rapidly evolving and constantly changing situation.

Visitors, at all times, are expected to adhere to the Alberta Health Services (AHS) protocols and Public Health Orders.

The availability of some amenities may be affected, depending on the level of restrictions instituted by the Province of Alberta.

It is up to you, our visitors, to camp responsibly during this time of COVID-19. You must maintain a social distance of at least six feet at all times, including when gathering outside in groups. Please remember to wash or sanitize your hands frequently.

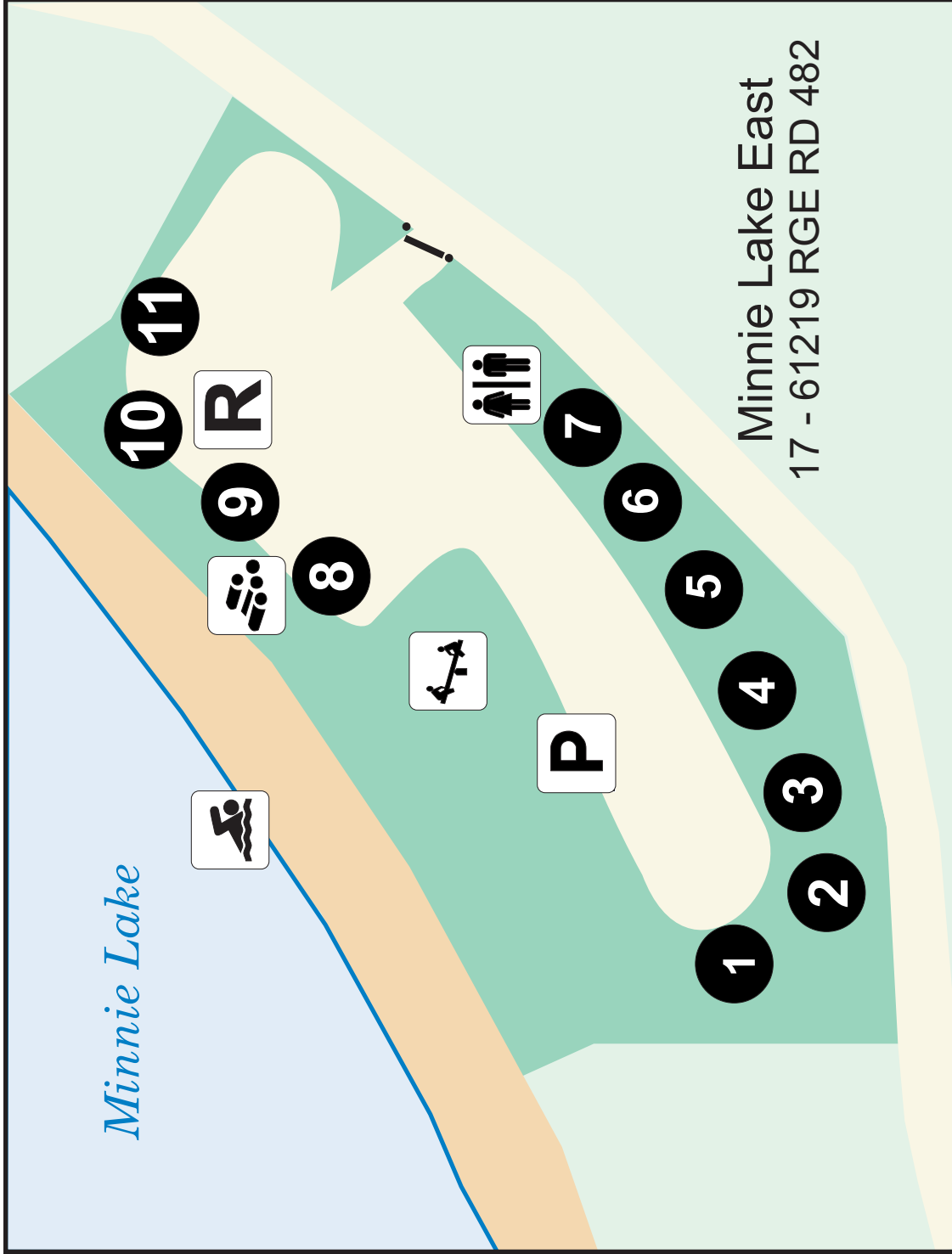
