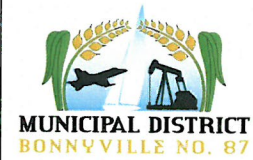

Title:	Developed Road Allowance Brush Control	Policy No: 30.32.05

Statement: The Municipal District of Bonnyville is the road authority responsible for the direction, control and management of all municipal roadways within its boundaries. The control of trees and/or brush on developed road allowances is necessary for public safety as it relates to site distance requirements, snow removal, drainage maintenance and other general roadside maintenance activities.

Trees and/or brush that create site line obstructions along developed road allowances within the MD will be controlled by the MD within annual budget limitations.

Purpose:

1. To establish a procedure that ensures adequate control of the removal of trees and/or brush along developed road allowances for the purpose of:
 - a. Reducing site line obstructions that may affect the travelling public.
 - b. Facilitating proper maintenance of municipal roadways within the MD.

Definitions: "MD" means the Municipal District of Bonnyville No. 87.
