

**Section: 4.0 Infrastructure Services**  
**- A. Roads**

**Authority: Council**

**Statement**

The Road Ban Committee only shall have the authority to place and/or lift road bans for all roads under the authority of the Municipal District of Bonnyville (M.D.).

**Purpose**

To provide a coordinated effort of placing road bans in the municipality; road bans are to be placed to preserve and protect the road grade.

**Policy**

- (1) A Road Ban Committee shall be struck consisting of:
  - (a) the Reeve;
  - (b) the General Manager of Infrastructure Services (or his designate); and
  - (c) the Chief Administrative Officer.
- (2) Any Councillor wishing to place a road ban must contact any of the above members requesting that a road ban be implemented, and the committee shall review and determine the requirement for such a ban prior to implementation.
- (3) All requests for the implementation of a road ban must be made at least 24 hours prior to the road ban coming into effect.
- (4) When a road ban is placed, the Infrastructure Services Department shall install the proper signage indicating the axle weight limit and remove same when the ban is lifted.
- (5) Administration is to notify Alberta Infrastructure and Transportation and M.D. Public Safety of all road bans in effect and when they are lifted.

**Policy Review**

Within five (5) years from date adopted / amended / reviewed.
