

Section: 4.0 Infrastructure Services
- A. Roads

Authority: General Manager of Infrastructure Services

Statement

- (1) All newly constructed road grades shall be graveled as soon as possible after acceptance of road construction.
- (2) All existing road grades shall be graveled in a timely manner when maintenance is required.
- (3) Road Approaches will be graveled at the discretion of the Infrastructure Services Department.
- (4) When a driveway approach required graveling, the approach shall be graveled starting from the shoulder of the road in towards the property line to a maximum of ten (10) cubic yards and/or as determined by the General Manager of Infrastructure Services.
- (5) The Municipal District of Bonnyville (M.D.) shall not:
 - (a) Provide gravel services for private driveways;
 - (b) Sell gravel.

Purpose

The Municipality seeks to:

- (1) Provide a safe travel surface and to protect newly constructed road surfaces as soon as possible after road construction.
- (2) Ensure the continued integrity of the road surface with timely maintenance.
- (3) Avoid the expenditure of public funds on private property.
