## Developed Road Allowance Brush Control Policy

**4A.013**

**Section:** 4.0 Infrastructure Services  
- A. Roads

**Authority:** General Manager of Infrastructure Services

### Statement

The Municipal District of Bonnyville (M.D.) is the road authority responsible for the direction, control, and management of all municipal roadways within its boundaries. The control of trees and/or brush on developed road allowances is necessary for public safety as it relates to site distance requirements, snow removal, drainage maintenance, and other general roadside maintenance activities.

Trees and/or brush that create site line obstructions along developed road allowances within the M.D. will be controlled by the municipality within annual budget limitations.

### Purpose

- (1) To establish a procedure that ensures adequate control of the removal of trees and/or brush along developed road allowances for the purpose of:
  - (a) reducing site line obstructions that may affect the travelling public;
  - (b) facilitating proper maintenance of municipal roadways within the M.D.

### Policy Review
